
TOOLTIN LEAF BLOWER

Leaf Blower Safety

- The leaf blower uses a mixture of gas and oil for the fuel. Make sure that the correct fuel is being used when filling up.
- Do not refuel when the engine is hot.
- Gloves can help to reduce the vibrations felt while using the blower.
- Make sure that all safety guards are in place before using.
- Do not point the blower at anyone while it is running.
- Always shut off the engine before setting the machine down.

- Safety Glasses (Recommended)
- Dust Mask (Recommended)

Operating Procedure


- Place blower on the ground for starting,
- Follow instructions on the blower for priming and choking the machine.
- Place one hand on the handle to keep the blower firmly on the ground.
- With the other hand, pull the starter cord until the blower is running.
- · Adjust the choke on the engine as needed.
- Use the blower to perform the task needed by pulling the throttle trigger.
- When finished, release the trigger and press the stop button.
- Allow the engine to stop completely before setting the blower down.
